

COAL STUDY UNIT COORDINATOR AWARDS PROGRAM

This program rewards Coal Study Unit Coordinators for excellence in performing their duties. The principal of each school is asked to appoint a teacher or member of his/her staff to the position of CSU Coordinator for their school. They will be responsible for distributing information from CEDAR pertaining to the Coal Study Unit Program, and organizing teachers who want to perform a CSU in the classroom.

Schools in the seven county target area will be divided into classes based on the number of teachers at the school. Class A will contain schools that have between 1 and 15 teachers, with Class B containing schools that have between 16 and 30 teachers, and Class C will contain schools that have 31+ teachers.

There will be one (1) winner from each Class listed above. The winner will be determined based on the following scoring system:

SCORING SYSTEM

- 1) Percent of scheduled meetings attended.
- 2) Percent of reports submitted by deadline.
- 3) Percent of teachers completing coal study units versus number of classroom teachers at your school.
- 4) Weighted average percent score of all coal study units from same school.

AWARDS PROGRAM

Cash awards will be based on the average percent of total points earned versus total points on the scoring system. Awards will be based on the following:
